N early fifty years after it was launched, it's become clear that the War on Cancer has failed. - Shares a six-point program (The Cowan Cancer Therapy) that includes advice on: diet, supplements, water, mistletoe therapy, and other interventions
- Offers a scathing look at the cancer screening process
